The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Nautan P.S. Case No. 125/2021 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 413/414 of the Indian Penal Code
and Sections 30 and 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to
withdraw this application to move the Trial Court for regular
bail after surrender.
