5 23-08-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Sections 364(A)/120B of the
Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, some unknown miscreants
kidnapped the son the informant, thereafter called the
informant's mobile and demanded ransom money of Rs. 30 lacs.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Petitioner is not named in the FIR rather
during investigation, the mobile no., which was used in
demanding of ransom money stands in the name of the
petitioner, but there is no consistent evidence has come against



the petitioner to show his complicity in the alleged occurrence. The victim boy has recovered and petitioner has neither any concern with the alleged occurrence nor the victim boy has recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail petition. He is languishing in judicial custody since 24.07.2022.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below in connection with Jokihat P.S. Case No. 455 of 2021.
