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- i. A writ in nature of mandamus or any other writ or order or direction be issued directing and commanding the authorities to quash the demand notice dated 04.11.2022 u/s 13(12), 13(4) and



Rule 8(1) of SARFACIE Act issued by authorised officer, Central Bank of India, Purnea (Annexure-6) and not to disturbed peaceful possession of petitioner order his house situated at Mauza-Birpur, Thana-K. Hatt (102) Purnea, Khata No. -317, Khesra No.-1594, 1595, Area 16 decimal 08 Kari bounded by:-

On the North-197 ft 06 inch Nij Seller

On the South-36 ft Bikki Singh

On the East-36 ft Village Pitch Road

On the West-36 ft Sadanand Biswa

ii. Any other writ or order or direction to which the petitioner is found entitled by this Hon'ble court may kindly be issued.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner shall take recourse to the remedies provided in accordance with law, and any such proceedings which may be initiated, be directed to be expedited.

Statement accepted and ordered accordingly.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings



are initiated by the petitioner, before the appropriate forum/Tribunal, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of 3/6 months.

Needless to add, period for which the petitioner has been pursuing the matter before this Court, shall be excluded for the purpose of computing limitation.
