2 05-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable u/s 341, 323, 307, 504, 506 and 34 IPC.

3. As per the prosecution case, the F.I.R. named accused persons including the petitioner surrounded the informant and his brother and started to assault them with lathi, danda etc.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged has ever taken place. There is case and counter-case between the parties and both sides have



sustained injuries, which were found simple in nature. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since the injury was found simple in nature, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Jamui P.S. Case No.403 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
