2 02-02-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 327, 471 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code pending in the learned court below.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the informant has tried to give the



civil dispute to appeal color of criminal offence by mixing the allegation of threat etc. He submits that there is land dispute between the parties which is clear from the FIR itself. He further submits that petitioners have got no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail application.

Learned APP for the State opposes for prayer for bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the fact that there is civil dispute between the parties, let the petitioners, named above, in the event of their arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Court below, where the case is pending/Successor court, in connection with Bettiah Mufassil P.S. Case No.673/2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
