2 16-05-2023 At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner no. 2 has already been arrested during the interregnum period, hence, the present petition *qua* him has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed as not pressed *qua* the petitioner no. 2.
