ORAL ORDER

3 18-12-2023 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of three weeks from today.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

3. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Bypass P.S Case No. 320 of 2023 dated 28.06.2023 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 413, 414, 420, 467, 468, 471/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

4. As per the prosecution case, one stolen pick up van loaded with stolen iron bore and one mobile phone were recovered. Further, the co-accused Rahul Kewat disclosed the name of the petitioner and others, who managed to escape.



5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned, Patna City in connection with Bypass P.S Case No. 320 of 2023, subject to conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

8. The application stands allowed.
