ORAL ORDER

2 03-07-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this application is directed for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus / any other appropriate writ / order / direction commanding the respondent District Magistrate, Bhojpur to Comply the order of 2nd Appellate Authority i.e. Respondent no. 2 dated 15/09/2022 passed in Misc. No. 429110219072104110/2A exercised power under Lok Sikayat Nivaran Adhiniyam, whereby the respondent no. 4 has been directed



to enquire into the matter regarding dispute of concerned land and take further action, if the land is not disputed."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies, as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
