2 20-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution case, in short, is that 927 liters wine is recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. The name of the petitioner has transpired as being the owner of one of six motorcycles recovered in this case. Said motorcycle was given by the petitioner to the co-villager for his personal use. It is alleged that 927 liters wine is recovered from



the motorcycles in question. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the alleged incident. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the order dated 13-04-2022 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Cr. Appeal No. 626 of 2022 (Sweta Kumari versus State of Bihar).

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the complaint case/F.I.R.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Madhubani in connection with Jay Nagar P.S. case No.227/2022 corresponding to G.R. No.1218 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
