3 28-03-2023 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the
State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Section 304(B) of the Indian
Penal Code.

It is a case of dowry death.

Petitioner is brother-in-law (Dewar of the deceased).

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that thrust of accusation is against husband of the deceased who
is already in custody. He next submits that no specific allegation
has been made against the petitioner. Petitioner is separate in
mess and property and is not concerned with the family affairs
of the couple. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let



the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara in Barhara P. S. Case No. 429 of 2019, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
