Petitioner, in the present case, is seeking a direction to
the respondent authorities to pay the arrears on account of
revised salary and allowances from the date of his joining in
service as Chowkidar at NCC Group Headquarter, Bhagalpur on
17th September 2009 till 31.03.2017.

petitioner has not approached the competent authority by filing
any representation or claim in respect of which he is seeking a
