ORAL ORDER

2 22-02-2023 This criminal revision application has been filed for setting aside order dated 19.11.2016 passed by Learned Sessions Judge, Munger, in Sessions Trial No. 222 of 2004 arising out of Taraput P.S. Case No. 150 of 2003, whereby, the petition filed by learned APP under section 311 Cr. P. C was allowed and was directed to produce the doctor the next day, fixed in the case.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner should also be given an opportunity to cross examine the doctor. It goes without saying that once a witness is



examined on behalf of the prosecution, the accused shall get an opportunity to cross examination.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I do not find any illegality or irregularity in the impugned order.

This criminal revision application is accordingly dismissed.
