2 29-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.

Brajendra Nath Pandey, learned APP for the State.

Petitioner in the present case is seeking pre-arrest bail in connection with Maranchi P.S. Case No. 35 of 2022 registered for the offences under Sections 341, 323, 325, 307, 379, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

As per the prosecution story, the informant namely Sanjay Ranjan in his written petition alleged that on 19.03.2022 at about 12:00 P.M., the petitioner namely Munna @ Anand and Chiku started abusing him in drunken condition. When the informant and his son protested, they assaulted them with lathi and danda which caused head injury to the informant and also back injury. The accused persons snatched the gold chain from the informant's neck.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a case and counter case between the parties, both the parties have settled their disputes amicably and a joint compromise petition has been filed vide Annexure '3' to the application.

Learned APP for the State is present and has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, considering that both the parties had a fight over some dispute of Patta of the land, there is a case and counter-case between the parties, the petitioner has also suffered injury and it is submitted that at this stage they have amicably settled their differences and disputes and a joint compromise petition vide Annexure '3' has been filed, this Court grants bail to the petitioner above-named in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today in connection with Maranchi P.S. Case No. 35 of 2022 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patna, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

And further condition that the court below shall verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and in case at any stage



it is found that the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedent, the court below shall take step for cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner. However, the acceptance of bail bonds in terms of the above-mentioned order shall not be delayed for purpose of or in the name of verification.

This application stands allowed.
