2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 325, 307, 504, 506, 379, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegedly, the petitioners and other co-accused persons brutally assaulted the informant's side by means of several weapons due to which they sustained injuries.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation against the petitioner no.1 is that he assaulted the son



of the informant but the injury is of simple nature and there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner no.2. He further submits that the specific allegation is against Bhola Yadav to assault the informant due to which her hand got fractured. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as there is no specific overt act against the petitioners, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Tiwar P.S. Case No.50 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
