Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise
Act, 2018.

Prosecution case is that 270 liters illicit liquor was
recovered from the 'Auto'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is neither owner nor driver of the vehicle. No
incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious
possession of the petitioner. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

Considering the facts of the case, in the event of
arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of



Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.D.J.-II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Katihar in connection with Nagar Police Station Case No. 416 of 2022, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
