ORAL ORDER

3 12-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the informant and learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 342, 376 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the informant, at the outset, submits that he has instruction of the informant not to oppose the anticipatory bail of the petitioners as the case was instituted under a misconception, it is further submitted that petitioner no.1 and the victim have already married and are living peaceful conjugal life.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners.



Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the informant, the petitioners above-named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Forbesganj P.S. Case No. 790 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
