Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Kopa P. S. Case No. 148 of 2019 dated 30.09.2019 registered
for the offences punishable u/ss 302, 120B read with Section 34
of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-
accused persons are alleged to have committed murder of the



husband of the informant due to previous enmity. They were seen fleeing away from the place of occurrence. It is further alleged that co-accused Dhaniya Devi got the husband of the informant murdered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. No such occurrence as alleged has ever taken place. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. The specific allegation has been attributed against the co-accused Dhaniya Devi, who has already been granted bail by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 03.01.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 12434 of 2022. The petitioner has got clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 02.10.2019

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Saran at Chapra in connection with Kopa P. S. Case



No. 148 of 2019.

The application stands allowed.
