2 23-03-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 307/504/506/34 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners are alleged to have abused and assaulted the informant by means of lathi, danda etc. and they also took away cycle of the husband of the informant

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. Injury caused by the petitioners has been found to be simple in nature by doctor. Petitioners have



got no criminal antecedent. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the nature of allegation against the petitioners, in the event of arrest/surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioners, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka in Katoriya Police Station Case No. 57 of 2021/GR No. 673 of 2021, subject to the conditions laid down under sections 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
