2 24-03-2023 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the
State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 414, 420, 467, 468,
379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution case, in brief, is that all the F.I.R. named
accused persons including this petitioner used to deceive people
by changing pins of their ATM cards in the ATM machine.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is innocent and has been made accused in this
case only on the basis of statement of one co-accused person.
No stolen or any incriminating article has been recovered from
his possession or premises. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let



the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest/surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada in Nawada P. S. Case No. 748 of 2017, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
