2 02-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Sandesh P.S. Case No. 93 of 2022 registered under Sections
471, 472, 467, 468, 420 and 188 of the Indian Penal Code and
Sections 25(1-b)a, 26 and 30 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further submission is that no
cartridge has been purchased by the petitioner after taking rifle
which is apparent from the license, as contained in Annexure-2
to the bail petition. Hence, the allegation of misusing the arm is
baseless, as the rifle can't be used or misused without cartridge.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ara in connection with Sandesh P.S. Case No. 93 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
