ORAL ORDER

2 06-04-2023 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove defect (s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a
period of four weeks on resumption of physical mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in connection with Sadar (Mabbi O.P.) P.S. Case
No. 518 of 2022 dated 24.08.2022 registered for the offence
punishable under sections 341, 342, 323, 363, 364 and 387 read
with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, two miscreants boarded
on a motorcycle came and forcibly took the informant to *Simra*
Nehalpur while the informant was getting his motorcycle
repaired. After sometime 4-5 persons came there in a *Indica* car
and they started searching pocket of the informant and found no



money in the pocket. Thereafter, they assaulted the informant and snatched his silver chain and ring. In the meantime, the police came and apprehended the petitioner and the co-accused persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is accused in two other criminal cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 25.08.2022.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Darbhanga at Laheriasarai in connection with Sadar (Mabbi O.P.)P.S. Case No. 518 of 2022.

The application stands allowed.
