2 19-09-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this writ application is for a direction to the respondent authorities to take disciplinary action against the respondent nos. 6 and 7 for establishing Jamabandi in regard to the land in question for which lands Jamabandi was established in the name of the petitioner more than three decades ago in accordance with law and it



was continuing till today and upto date land Revenue was paid and behind the back of the petitioner and without any notice to the petitioner in the circumstances set forth below.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
