ORAL ORDER

2 12-04-2023 The present petition has been filed seeking the
following relief :-

*“(i) For issuance of an appropriate writ,
order/ orders, directions/ directions in the
nature of certiorari for quashing the vague,
incorrect and incomplete notice dated
29.11.2022 issued in Encroachment case no.
4/2022-23 in purported exercise of the power
under Section 3 of the Bihar Public Land
Encroachment Act, 1956 in respect of the
alleged projection as the first floor of the
house situated for the last several
generation.”*

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner



seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Chewara, Sheikhpura by filing his objection to the notice issued under Section 3 of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, in connection with Encroachment case no. 04 of 2022-23. Liberty so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands disposed off as not pressed.
