Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 337, 338, 353, 186 and 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per FIR, 373 named persons including the petitioner and 100 unknown persons restored to blockage of road and committed violence with the police party in protest of death of one person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that there is no specific overt act against the petitioner. He submits that there is general and omnibus allegation levelled against the petitioner. He submits that



similarly situated co-accused have already been granted bail by coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 06.12.2022 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 46002 of 2022. He further submits that petitioner has criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Balthar P.S. Case No. 44 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
