ORAL ORDER

2 02-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case in
connection with Town P.S. Case No. 322 of 2023 dated
13.04.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/s 414 of the
Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the stolen motorcycle
was recovered from the co-accused Ravi Kumar Tiwari and he
stated that the said motorcycle was purchased from the
petitioner at the price of Rs. 4000/-. It is further alleged that the
petitioner is engaged in trade of stolen motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. The



name of the petitioner was disclosed by the co-accused, Ravi Kumar Tiwari. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner rather the stolen motorcycle has been recovered from the co-accused, Ravi Kumar Tiwari. No case is made out against the petitioner. The petitioner has two criminal antecedent as stated at para 3 of the bail petition.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned, Saran at Chapra in connection with Town P.S. Case No. 322 of 2023, subject to conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

7. The application stands allowed.
