5 19-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 379, 356 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per prosecution case, while the informant was returning after withdrawing the amount of Rs. 39,000/- from PNB, Phulparas, meanwhile two unknown miscreants came and snatched the aforesaid amount from the informant. Thereafter, this case has been lodged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. rather he has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner was arrested in



Choghradiha P.S. case no. 42 of 2022 in which the petitioner made his self confession and on the basis of same, he was remanded in this case. Nothing looted article has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner. TI Parade has also not been held as yet. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 10.8.2022.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Phulparas P.S. Case No. 97 of 2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-III, Jhanjharpur, Madhubani.
