ORAL ORDER

3 15-03-2023 Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 307, 323, 302, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and 27/35 of Arms Act.

Vide order dated 25.01.2023, a report was called for, regarding the stage of trial. In compliance thereof, a report sent by Additional Sessions Judge 1st, Gaya dated 03.02.2023, kept at flag 'A', whereby it is submitted that out of 14 prosecution witnesses, 10 witnesses have been examined and 4 witnesses are yet to be examined and the time likely to be taken in conclusion of the trial is about six months, if parties co-operate.

Considering the submissions made in the report, I am not



inclined to grant bail to the petitioner named above. The prayer for bail is hereby rejected.

Accordingly, the bail application is dismissed.

However, the trial court is directed to conclude the trial as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
