2 15-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P.
for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of Bihar Excise and Prohibition (Amendment) Act, 2018.

3. Altogether 31.875 litres foreign liquor has been recovered from a hut situated behind the house of petitioner.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern either with the seized liquor or place of recovery or any trade of liquor. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is general



and omnibus in nature. He was not apprehended on the spot. He had not consumed liquor. His name has been transpired in the present case due to ulterior motive. Petitioner has two criminal antecedents of similar nature that of the present case.

5. Petitioner is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs. 20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand) in account of Mahavir Cancer Sansthan, Patna, bearing Account No.3332964762, IFSC Code: CBIN0282779, MICR Code: 800016018, Central Bank of India, Chitkohra Branch, Patna.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Samastipur Excise P.S. Case No. 524 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C, subject to the further conditions that

(1) One of the bailors will be his own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or his wife.

(2) The petitioner shall not indulge himself in any simi-



lar offence till conclusion of the trial.

7. The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned Court below on showing receipt of deposit of the afore-said amount in Mahavir Cancer Sansthan, Patna.
