The present writ application has been filed for the
purpose of proper investigation in connection with Mahila P.S.
Bagaha Case No. 84 of 2022 dated 01.11.2022 lodged under
Sections 341/ 323/ 427/ 354/ 504/ 506/ 34 of the I.P.C. read with

Sections 3(1)(r)(s)(w)/ 3(2)(v)(a) of SC/ ST Act.

Counsel for State submits that this case may be disposed off in the light of order passed in *Surendra Singh Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.* in *Cr. WJC. No. 153 of 2017* and analogous cases decided on 09.09.2022.

In this view of the matter, the present criminal writ petition is **disposed off** with direction to the petitioner to file representation before the Superintendent of Police, West Champaran in the light of the order passed in *Surendra Singh Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.* in *Cr. WJC.
