A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 379, 308, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, petitioners along with other accused persons came to the informant house and abused him and his family members. On objection, they assaulted them indiscriminately with deadly weapons.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. No such occurrence as alleged ever took place. Both the parties



are co-villagers. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to ulterior motive. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is specific allegation of assault against co-accused Mukku Manjhi, Balchand Manjhi and Tipu Manjhi. Petitioners have not caused any injuries to anyone. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as there is no specific overt act against the petitioners, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Atri P.S. Case No. 284 of 2021, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
