It appears from the statements made in paragraphs '8' and '9' of the counter affidavit filed on behalf of respondent no. 2 that after investigation of the case, inspection of the place of occurrence and upon recording of the statements of the victim girl under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the case has been found under the category of mistake of facts.
