A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 328, 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. All the F.I.R. named accused persons including this petitioner, on non-fulfillment of demand of dowry, in furtherance of the common intention are said to have committed murder of the daughter of the informant.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. No such occurrence as alleged ever took place. He is *Nandoi* of the deceased. He has been falsely implicated in this case due to



ulterior motive. He has no concern with the daily affairs of the deceased and her husband. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is specific allegation against co-accused Pulkit Sah, husband of the deceased, who was acquitted by learned Court below vide Sessions Trial No. 277 of 2023 dated 05.07.2023. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as there is no specific overt act against the petitioner, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Alauli P.S. Case No. 478 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
