learned APP for the State.

The petitioner has filed the instant application

for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the

offences punishable under Sections 323, 498(A) of the

Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition

Act.

It is a case of cruelty and ousting the

complainant from her matrimonial house due to non



fulfilment of dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that petitioner is ready to keep his wife but she is not inclined to live with the petitioner. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 08.08.2022. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail in connection with Complaint Case No. 268 of 2018 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to



the satisfaction of the learned Sub Divisional Judicial
Magistrate, Arwal.
