2 18-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are languishing in custody in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) and 56(b) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

There is recovery of 240 litres of illicit country made liquor from an auto-rickshaw.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been



recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have no concern either with the seized auto-rickshaw or the illicit liquor. The petitioners are languishing in custody since 05.08.2023. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

In contra, learned A.P.P appearing on behalf of the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the period under custody, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 1251 of 2023.
