There are certain disputed claim to the extent that due to dispute over proprietorship/partnership issue, the official respondents have not settled the claim of the petitioner. There are certain dispute that is required to be adjudicated or resolved among the partners. If the petitioner claims that work order and



consequential order from time to time till completion of work is undertaken in the name of proprietorship, in that event he is permitted to produce all necessary documents before the concerned authority to examine the claim once again.
