2 12-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304(B), 201, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. All the F.I.R. named accused persons including this petitioners, on non-fulfillment of demand of dowry, in furtherance of the common intention are said to have committed murder of the daughter of the informant after assaulting and concealed her dead body.

4. It is submitted by learned senior counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have



committed no offence. No such occurrence as alleged ever took place. Petitioners are father-in-law and mother-in-law of the deceased. Petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to ulterior motive. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner further submits at bar, that the husband of the deceased has already surrendered before the learned Court below on 11.12.2023. Petitioner no.1 has three criminal antecedents, whereas petitioner no.2 has two criminal antecedents as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, as husband of the deceased has surrendered before the learned Court below, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned lower Court where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Biddupur
