2 04-02-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP
for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable u/s 341, 323, 324, 307, 504 & 34 IPC.

As per the prosecution case, the F.I.R. named accused
persons including the petitioners indiscriminately assaulted the
informant's side by means of various weapons.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that
petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence.
They have been falsely implicated in this case due to land
dispute. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever



taken place. The allegation leveled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. It is submitted that for the alleged occurrence, there is case and counter-case between the parties and both sides have sustained grievous injuries. The parties are agnates. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since both sides have sustained grievous injuries, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Sono (Charka Pathar) P.S. Case No.297 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
