2 13-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned A.P.P appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are languishing in custody in a

case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 304(B), 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing the daughter of the

informant for non-fulfillment of dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the



petitioners that petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner No. 1 is mother-in-law whereas petitioner No. 2 is sister-in-law (*Jethani*) of the deceased and they had no concern with the day-do-day affairs of the deceased and her husband. The petitioners live separately from the husband of the deceased. The victim had committed suicide due to depression and remorse as she was willing to live with her husband at his work place, who was residing outside the country for his livelihood. Moreover, good sense has prevailed between the parties and both sides have compromised the matter, the compromise petition has been annexed as Annexure-P4 to the petition. The petitioners are languishing in custody since 24.08.2023.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the period under custody, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional
