seeking the following relief:-

*“1.That this is an application for issuance
of appropriate writ/order/direction
commanding the respondent authorities
to remove the encroachment from the*



public Land bearing plot no. 2032 Under Khata no. 8 of Mauza Hasanpur Anchal Dhaka, District- East Champaran recorded in the right of record as Gairmazarua Aam, in the light of provisions of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 resurfaced by the private respondent no. 10 and 11 after removal of encroachment by the order of this Hon'ble Court. dated 07-07-2022 passed in C.W.J.C. No.1378 of 2020."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Dhanka, District-East Champaran, for redressal of his aforesaid grievance.

Liberty so sought is granted.

It is needless to state that in case the petitioner approaches the Circle Officer, Dhaka, District-East Champaran, by filing appropriate petition under the provisions of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered, in accordance with law and after



hearing the affected parties, appropriate orders shall be passed thereon, forthwith.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
