Petitioner seeks bail, who is in custody since
24.01.2020, in connection with Chandi P.S. Case No. 115 of
2017 corresponding to Sessions Trial No. 50 of 2021, F.I.R.
dated 31.10.2017 registered for the offences punishable under
Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the
Arms Act.
