2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case  
  
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 406/420  
  
of the Indian Penal Code and Section 138 of the Negotiable  
  
Instrument Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, allegation against  
  
the petitioner is that he took books on credit from the  
  
complainant on different dates but he willfully did not pay the  
  
entire amount and the cheques given by the petitioner were  
  
dishonored.

4. By order dated 16.05.2023, this matter was



referred to the Patna High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre to resolve the dispute between the parties.

5. The learned Mediator vide its report dated 26.06.2023 has, inter alia, reported that a settlement has been arrived at between the parties as per the terms and conditions as mentioned in the report.

6. As the dispute has already been resolved between the parties, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Complaint Case No. 46 of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
