Addl. Public Prosecutor.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case
registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

96 liters of country-made liquor has been recovered
from E-Rickshaw.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that nothing
has been recovered from the conscious possession of the
petitioners. Petitioners are neither owner nor driver of the said
vehicle and they have got no concern with the alleged recovery.
Petitioners have got clean antecedent.



Considering the nature of allegation and clean antecedent of petitioners, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest or surrender within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt / production of copy of this order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise, Patna City (Patna) in connection with Nadi P.S. Case No. 407 of 2022, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
