ORAL ORDER

3 02-01-2023 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief/s:-



1. That this is an application for issuance of a Writ of Certiorari or other appropriate Writ(s), Order(s), Direction(s), commanding the respondents to forebear from giving any effect on the public notice contained in Memo No.1495/RA, dated 14.10.2019, issued by the Collector, Saran at Chapra inviting tender for settlement of the Mela Sairat for the Harihar Kshetra, Sonapur Mela, 2019 on 31.10.2019 and setting aside the same on the ground that the security deposit amount for the Bakast Sairat is only for RS. 1,96,650/- and against the Gairmazarua Mela for Rs. 86,250/- which is fixed every year but the adjacent land known as Nakhas Kshetra of Sonapur Mela, 2019 which is fixed year to year increasing 10% of the cost to the last year cost. Secondly the Nakhas Kshetra of Sonapur Mela is auctioned by the Tourism Department only for 7 Acres and this year the tender has been invited



for Rs. 2 Crores, 74 Lakhs with specific areas, boundaries, Mauza, plots, Khatas are mentioned but the impugned Tender bid does not contain the map including details and particulars of land for the Sonapur Mela. The tender is allotted to the Respondents-2nd Set from beginning. They are the sons, musclemen and the henchmen of Late Amarendra Narayan Singh @ Bachcha Babu. The Tourism Department had/has been assigned to superintend over the Sonapur Mela settlement but only 7 Acres of Nakhas Kshetra land is given to be settled. The Respondents-1st Set have adopted ultramodern corrupt practice to rob the revenue year by year withing, growing any security money for the tender and further be pleased to direct the respondent 1st Set not to encroach the private lands of the residents there.

On 13.12.2022, we had passed the following order:



“To us, it appears that the present petition has become infructuous, for the period for which the shop was to be allotted, is over.

Despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

However, in the interest of justice, matter is adjourned.

List this case on 20th of December, 2022, in the category of “Order Matters”.”

Even today, despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed for default.
