2 15-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner rather 126 liters of country made liquor and a sack containing of 43.2 litres of IMFL are said to have recovered from the place of the occurrence. He further submits that allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other co-accused managed to ran away from the place of occurrence. He submits that on a secret information the



petitioner has been made accused in this case. He further submits that there is no recovery made from the conscious possession of the petitioner. He submits that petitioner has got three criminal antecedents in similar nature of the offence as stated in para-3 of the bail application.

4. Petitioner is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs. 20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand) in the account of Mahavir Cancer Sansthan, bearing Account No. 3332964762, IFSC Code: CBIN0282779 (fifth character is zero), Central Bank of India, Chitkohra Branch.

5. Considering the facts and circumstance of the case, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Aurangabad Town P.S. Case No. 754 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C., with further conditions:

(i) One of the bailors will be his own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or his wife.



(ii) The petitioner shall not indulge himself in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.

6. The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned Court below on showing receipt of the aforesaid amount in the account of Mahavir Cancer Sansthan, Patna.
