APP for the State.

The petitioners have prayed for regular bail in a case
registered for the offence punishable under sections 304(B), 34
of the Indian Penal Code.



As per prosecution case, the informant alleged that the petitioners along with his family members used to torture his daughter due to non-fulfillment of dowry demand. It is further alleged that they also killed her daughter due to non-fulfillment of the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. The petitioners are father-in-law and brother-in-law of the deceased due to which they have falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioners have no concern mess and business of the deceased as well as her husband and was living separately from them. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners and there is no eye-witness of the alleged occurrence. It is further submitted that the husband of the deceased is already in judicial custody. The petitioners are languishing in judicial custody since 11.09.2023.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The above named petitioners are directed to be released on bail in connection with



Bhabua P.S. Case No. 752 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabhua.
