2 20-12-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner has filed the instant application for
grant of regular bail in connection with Barh(Excise) P.S.
Case No. 1445 of 2023 registered under section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Prosecution case relates to recovery of 40 liters of
country made liquor from a motorcycle.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has
falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted



that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner and he has no concern with the seized illicit liquor. There is no independent witness of the seizure list rather they are police personnel. Moreover, he is languishing in judicial custody since 17.10.2023.

The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State and submitted that the petitioner has been arrested by the police.

The petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rs. Five Thousand) in the District Legal Services Authority of the concerned District.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the custody of the petitioner, the Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail in connection with Barh (Excise) P.S. Case No. 1445 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Exclusive Special Judge, Excise, Barh.

The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned lower Court below on showing the receipt of



deposit of Rs. 5,000/- (Rs. Five Thousand) by the petitioner
in the account of concerned DLSA.
