6 04-10-2023 Heard Mr. Jitendra Kumar Shrivastwa, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, Mr. Ritesh Kumar, learned counsel for the J.P. University and Mr. Anil Singh, learned counsel for the B.R.A. Bihar University.

2. A show cause affidavit has been filed on behalf of the Opposite Party nos. 6 & 8. Mr. Ritesh Kumar, learned counsel for the J.P.
