ORAL ORDER

5 24-04-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner has filed the present Cr. Writ Petition for setting aside Danapur P.S. Case No. 542 of 2019, lodged under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468/34 of the I.P.C. dated 05.07.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Hon'ble Court in the case of *Surendra Singh Vs. State of Bihar*



and others vide order dated 09.09.2022 passed in ***Cr.W.J.C. No. 153 of 2017*** with analogous cases, a direction was given to the petitioners to represent the entire matter before the Superintendent of Police and the Superintendent of Police was directed to take appropriate action in the said matter upon receiving the representation, within a fixed time period. He submits that the present case is squarely covered with the case of Surendra Singh Vs. State of Bihar and others.

In this view of the matter, petitioner is directed to file representation before the Superintendent of Police, Patna in the light of order passed in the case of ***Surendra Singh Vs. State of Bihar and others*** on 09.09.2022 in ***Cr. W.J.C. No. 153 of 2017*** with analogous cases within four weeks from the date of passing of this order.

The Superintendent of Police, Patna is directed to take necessary steps for completion of fair investigation at the earliest.

With the aforesaid direction, the present Cr. Writ Petition is hereby disposed off.
