3 04-01-2023 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 30.7.12019 passed by Certificate Officer, Banka passed in Certificate Case No. 56/2014-15 contained in Annexure-3 to this petition, by which a B/W was issued against the petitioner due to non deposit of remaining certificate amount without considering the facts that as per Hon’ble Patna High Court’s direction passed in



Cr. Misc. No. 21643/2015 on 15.05.2015, the petitioner is requires to deposit 50% of his salary towards the repayment of certificate amount but the petitioner has not paid his salary regularly month to month basis and after a gap of 4 to 6 months, when the petitioner received salary, he is depositing the amount and is ready to comply the same.”
