counsel for the State.

2. The petitioners' claim regularization by virtue of services being rendered on daily wages at the Sadar Hospital, Arwal, since 2012. He submits that various advertisements have been issued, in the meantime, for empanelling candidates in order of seniority of their existence in the daily wage establishment for the purposes of regularization/regular



appointment. The writ application does not disclose that any process has been undertaken, wherein, the petitioners have suffered any discrimination or deprivation.

3. The petitioners are said to be working on daily wages till date. At best, the Court would observe that as and when the process is undertaken, the petitioners would be considered in accordance with law.

4. The writ application is disposed of.
